



Global Change Network, U.S.A. Ordination Program

The purpose of this document is to outline procedures and expectations for candidates in the Global Change Network, U.S.A. Ordination Program.

Attendance Policy:

Regular attendance is required of all students to successfully complete each course. Courses have been carefully selected and planned to provide effective training. Therefore, candidates are expected to arrive on-time for classes. Late arrivals and/or absenteeism can prohibit candidates from continuing the Ordination Program.

The general attendance requirements, based upon the course length, are listed below:

- For 6 to 7 week courses, students may not be absent more than one (1) time.
- For 8 to 11 week courses, students may not be absent more than two (2) times.
- For 12 to 13 week courses, students may not be absent more than three (3) times.

Class Requirements for Ordination:

Ordination candidates must pass all classes to be ordained; to include all required workshops and mandatory meetings. Candidates must also have all applicable fees paid (application, CVTS registration, and book fees.)

Dismissal from Ordination Program:

The Global Change Network Board of Directors has the authority to suspend or terminate a candidate if it is determined that:

- Candidate does not display spiritual maturity for the role of leadership.
- Candidate does not meet the attendance requirements.
- Candidate fails to maintain a Godly life and Christian character and conduct.
- Candidate's belief system is not scripturally based and in line with Global Change Network, U.S.A. values.
